## How to Enter and Contest Rules

1. Come by City Hall enter the contest for only \$5.
2. Either use your own clothes or donate gently used clothes to Bryan County Family Connections and exchange them for scarecrow clothes!
3. Have your scarecrow displayed standing or sitting and post a 'selfie' with your scarecrow on our Facebook event page by Friday October 7th. School groups may use the Art Center window.
4. Entries will be judged for the grand prize of free PAC TV commercial time on Friday October 28<sup>th</sup> on creativity in materials and design and featured in our November city newsletter.
5. All entries will be photographed and the one that gets the most 'likes' on our Facebook event page over the weekend will win 'People's Choice Award' of \$10 and featured in our November city newsletter.
6. Scarecrows must be between 4 and 7 foot tall and may be inside or outside as long as it is visible from and within six feet of the front entrance.
7. Scarecrow families or groups will be charged \$3 for additional scarecrows if you'd like them to be judged. If not, please mark or specify which scarecrow is being judged.
8. Props are encouraged as long as they do not block the sidewalk, are easily carried away by wind or rain or pose any hazard to pedestrians.
9. All scarecrows must be family-friendly. Any scarecrow deemed inappropriate by the judges will not be judged and the entry fee or fees forfeited.

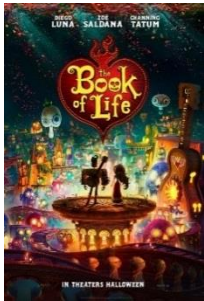

Cemetery lots are available in two sizes:

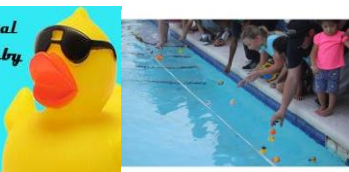
1. 10 ft. x 10 ft. lots will be \$750.00 and are for the interment of two.
