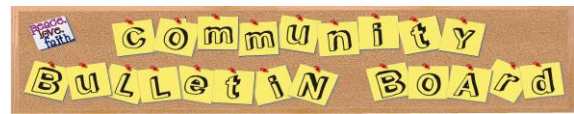
REMEMBERING 9/11
