- Additional costs for this event include the portable restroom rentals, which have historically been \$750 and are covered by the revenue generated

from the vendor registrations fees currently totaling \$4,205.49 in the PayPal Account

- Pembroke Historic District Walking Tour Launching on November 23rd
 - Fernanda Camacho Hauser provided an update regarding the launch of the historic walking tours, there were 16 people registered to participate with 4 attending
 - Board members were provided with pamphlets and window decals with the access code to the platform to host at their businesses if they so wished.
 - Jonathan mentioned some concerns about the quality of some of the images on the mobile version of the tour
